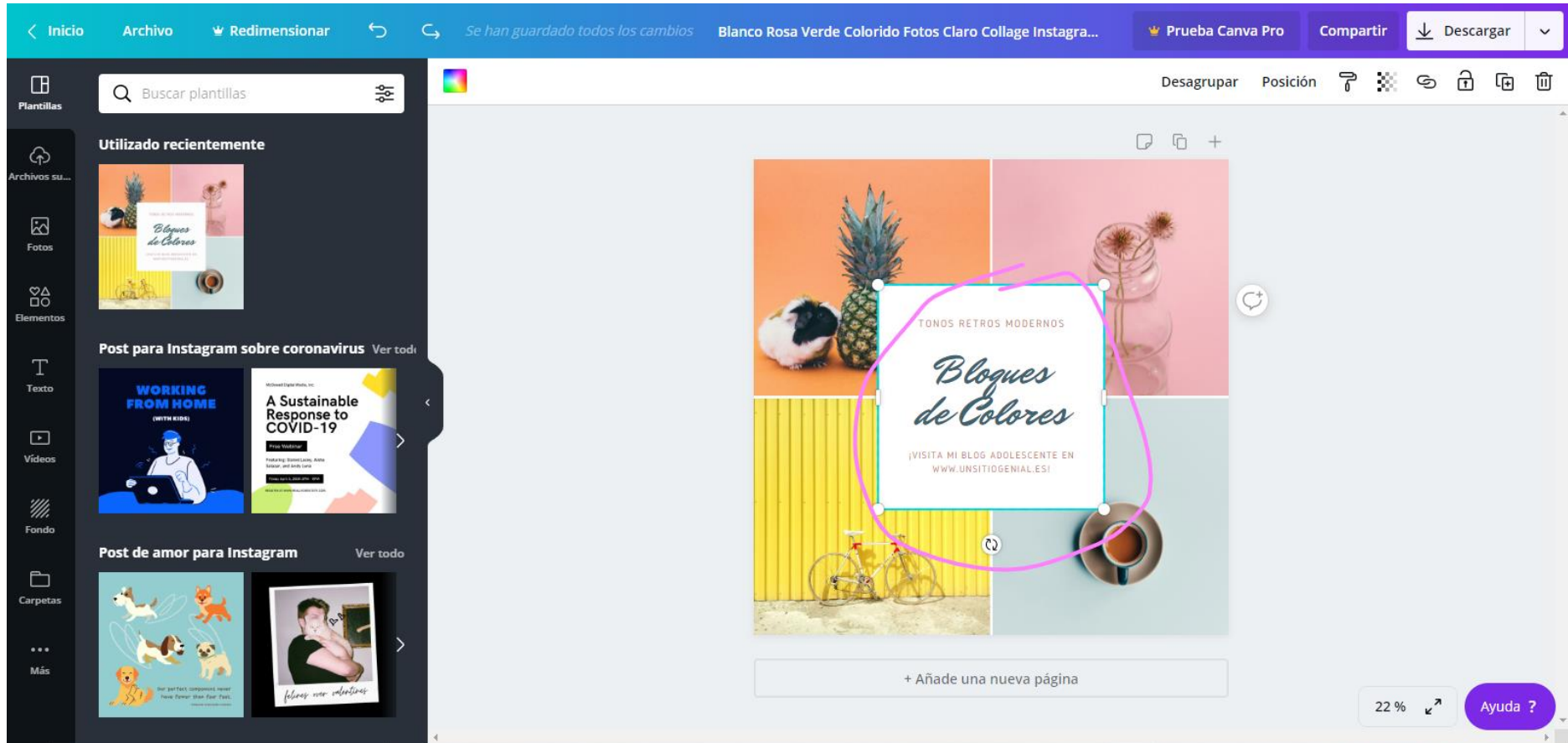

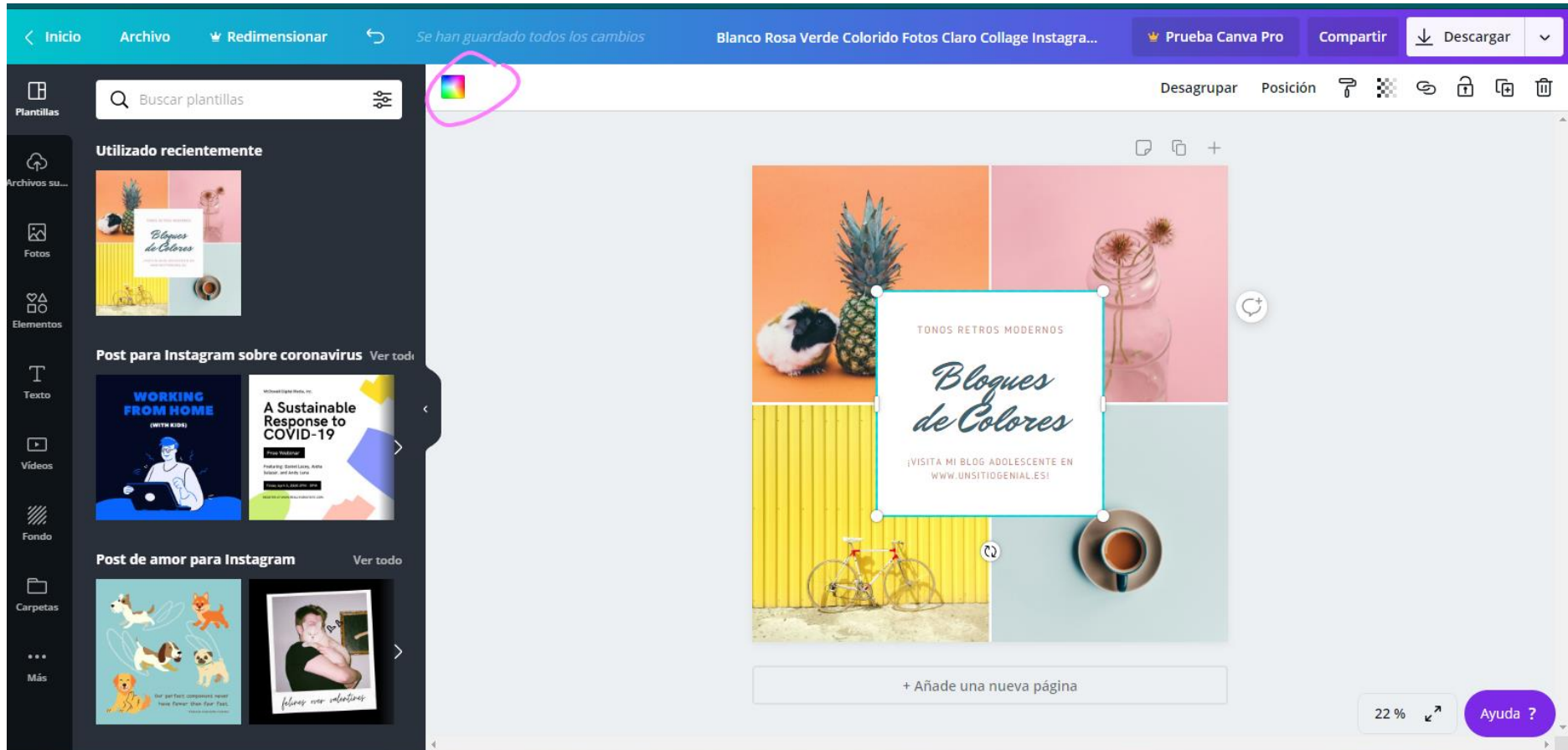
### 1. Elijo un diseño

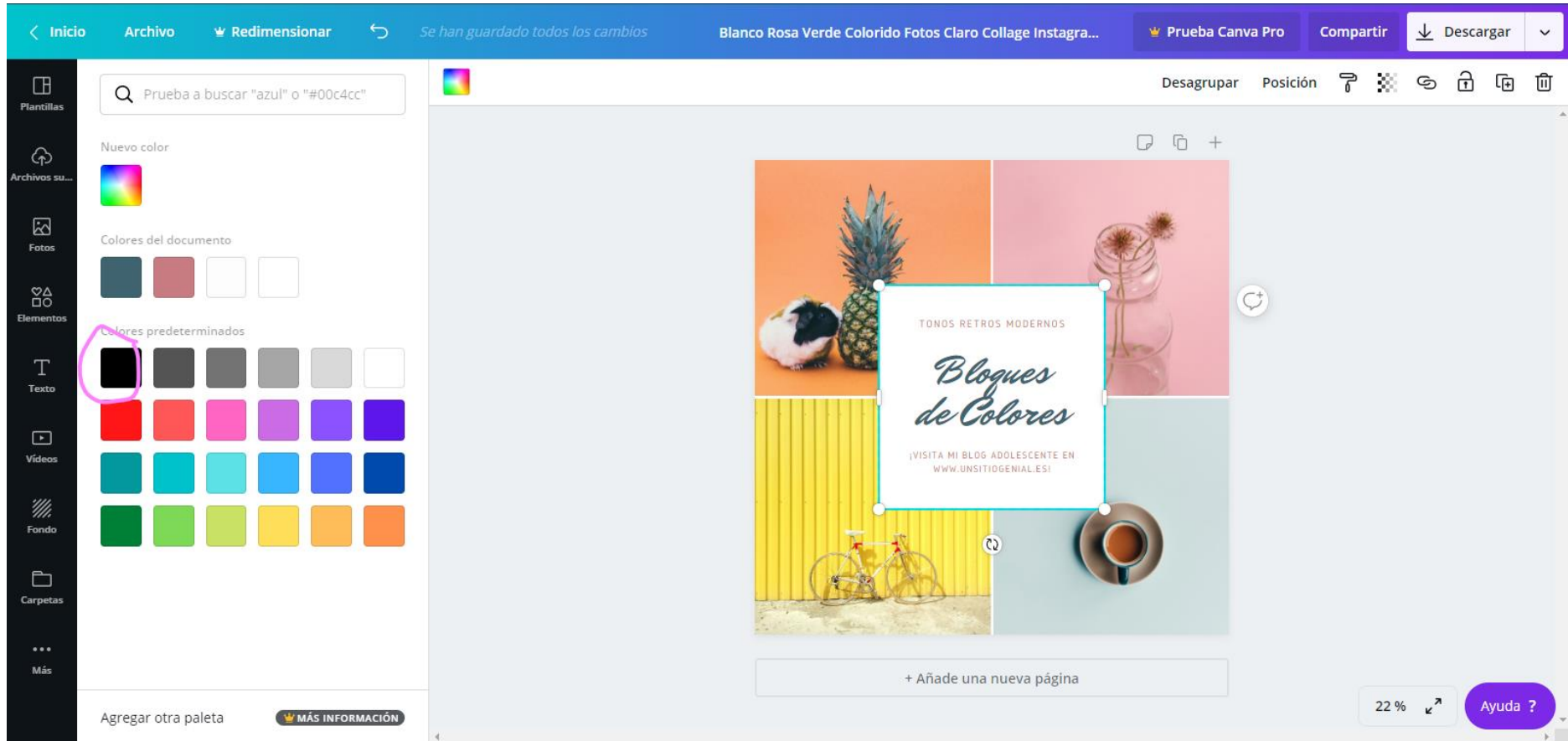
2. Selecciono el recuadro central donde está el texto
